Our language programme

Our language programme is a two-week course running from 28 July to 11 August 2024, we accept students of any level from age 11 up to 16 years old.

They receive 20 hours of comprehensive English lessons each week, with classes segmented for ages 11-13 and 14-16, this is done to make sure that each learning environment is age-appropriate.

Our teachers have vast experience and are passionate about education, ensuring every lesson is fun and full of intrigue. They track each pupil's progress, offering feedback and guidance, to encourage personal growth.

Arrival & Care

We understand travelling can be daunting for some. On arrival, each student will be greeted by a Bryanston staff member, before being transferred to Bryanston in one of our coaches, or through transportation organised by our expert team.

Transfers

Transfers on the designated arrival and departure dates from the aforementioned airports are included in the course fee. However, should you need transfers outside these dates or from other airports, these can be organised at an additional charge.

By Rail

For those preferring a rail journey, Poole and Salisbury stations are accessible by direct trains from London. We arrange for approved taxi pickups from these stations to ensure pupils reach Bryanston safely and promptly.

Departure

Your child will be accompanied to the airport, where we will help them check-in their luggage and assist them through the passport control process and onto security ready to fly home.

If your child is registered as an unaccompanied minor with their airline, we will handle the check-in process with the airline staff. Kindly share any details regarding these arrangements with us.
